

your dash?



# REFORMATION SUNDAY

October 31, 1517 is the date given for the start of the Protestant Reformation. It was the reclaiming of biblical truth. There were five "Solas" (meaning 'alone') of this movement: Glory to God alone, Scripture alone, Faith alone, Grace alone, and Christ alone. The central issue was the doctrine of justification by faith alone. The recapturing of this truth paved the way for the Protestant movement and the continued growth of the church. Reformation Sunday this year is October 30th.
